

# ***King George County Electoral Board Meeting Minutes***

## **I. Call to order**

Phyllis Cook called to order the regular meeting of the King George County Electoral Board at 11:15a on November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025, to review and approve new Officers of Election for the 2025 General Election.

## **V. New business**

- a) Review the minutes from the August 18 meeting.
  - (i) The minutes were read. Jay Faison moved that the minutes be approved. Phyllis Cook seconded. Passed by unanimous voice vote of all Board members.
- b) Jay Faison moved for the Board to go into Closed Session under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act, §2.2-3711 – A.1 to review additional candidates as Officers of Election per Code of Virginia §24.2-115, specifically newly trained candidates, with General Registrar, Lorrie Gump. Seconded by Phyllis Cook. Passed by unanimous voice vote of all Board members.
- c) The Board returned to Open Session under Section 2.2-3712 certifying that to the best of each member's knowledge (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under this chapter and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion by which the closed meeting was convened were heard, discussed or considered in the meeting by the public body.” Approved and certified by an individual voice vote by each Board member.

d) Actions from the Closed Session

1. Jay Faison moved to appoint three (3) new Officers of Election. Seconded by Phyllis Cook. Passed by unanimous voice vote of all Board members.

e) Time was given to discuss Board Member distribution to precincts during the closing process to Passapatanzy, Courthouse, and Shiloh.

f) It was communicated that there may be a special election regarding redistricting during April 2026.

g) The Registrar notified the Board that there may be a complaint by a voter during Early Voting concerning closing polls time.
