



A Resolution Requesting a Speed Study and Speed Limit Sign on
Luther Lane, State Route 690 & Rectory Lane, State Route 676

WHEREAS, the King George County Board of Supervisors is concerned about the safety and travel along Luther Lane (State Route 690) and Rectory Lane (State Route 676); and,

WHEREAS, a speed limit is not posted on either Luther Lane (0.16 miles in length) or Rectory Lane (0.30 miles in length); and,

WHEREAS, L.E. Smoot Memorial Library proposes to construct an addition with newly designed entrances on Luther Lane and Rectory Lane, and with the Board of Supervisors being concerned regarding site distance and ensuring safety and travel along each road; and,


WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) is responsible for setting safe speed limits along secondary roads in Virginia after certain studies are completed;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the King George County Board of Supervisors that VDOT is hereby requested to:

1. Perform a speed study on Luther Lane (State Route 690) and Rectory Lane (State Route 676) from the intersection of Kings Highway (State Route 3) to the end of each road to determine the appropriate safe speed for all vehicles that travel along these roads. The Board of Supervisors recommends that a speed limit of 25 miles per hour be posted.
2. Complete the study in the next thirty (30) days.
3. Place speed limit signs at appropriate locations along this road for safety purposes
