**RESOLUTION**

***In recognition of James Pitts for his outstanding farm conservation management practices which includes implementation of a farm nutrient management plan,***

**BE IT KNOWN Among All Within the County of King George**

**That the Tri-County/City Soil and Water Conservation District serves this community through programs and activities that enhance water quality of our surface and ground waters; while conserving and protecting our natural resources.**

**That in cooperation with the Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation, farmers who demonstrate outstanding management practices which conserve our precious natural resources are selected and recognized through the Clean Water/Bay Friendly Farm Award Program.**

**That the Tri-County/City SWCD has selected James Pitts as the Clean Water/Bay Friendly Farm Award Program recipient of King George County for 2008.**

**That James Pitts demonstrates a commitment to the conservation of the natural resources on his farm through responsible farm management practices: obtaining a soil sample and following the recommendation to apply the correct amount of fertilizer for the crop planted; removing steeper land out of production and planting grass to prevent soil from washing into nearby streams; using a no-till system to plant small grains, corn and soybeans without distributing the soil and keeping a cover on the land at all times to prevent soil and wind erosion.**

**BE IT RESOLVED by the King George County Board of Supervisors, that James Pitts is hereby commended for his commitment to protecting and enhancing waters that flow beyond farm boundaries and for the conservation ethic he demonstrates through his farm management practices.**
