Hi Ladies - Thank you all for volunteering to personally contact the individual supervisors.

- King George Relay For Life is a community event that celebrates survivorship and raises much needed funds for cancer research
- \$178,000 was raised in 2009 with 103 survivors being recognized. King George is in the top ten per cap in the nation. What an amazing accomplishment for a community with a population of 22,000
- The King George Relay is considered a gourmet event providing a vast array of foods by the 50+ teams
- Approximately \$40,000 is raised at the event and the majority of that is from food sales
- Safe food handling procedures are followed at the event and we have never had an incident
- The American Cancer Society carries a certificate of insurance for the event.

The Fredericksburg Health Department would not allow us to hold the kickoff because community members were preparing the food in their homes and bringing it to the event which is not allowed by the department of health. After speaking with the health department and reading the VA health department codes we discovered an

exception to the code. We are asking the Board of supervisors to provide an ordinance stating this code does not apply to Relay. Robyn Barber, ACS staff rep, could be the qualified person supervising the sale of food.

B. The governing body of any county, city or town may provide by ordinance that this chap athletic activities, if such booths are promoted or sponsored by any political subdivisio organization or group thereof. The ordinance shall provide that the director of the count activities are held, or a qualified person designated by the director, shall exercise suc prescribe.
