

- 9. Chesapeake 2000 Agreement – This documentation was provided to the Board in January. The public comment period on the agreement ends March 31, and any comments the County wishes to submit should be finalized by the March 21 Board meeting.

Recommendation: Submit written comments to the County Administrator for finalization and approval by the Board at the March 21 meeting.

- 10. Designation of Central Virginia Housing Coalition as the County's Indoor Plumbing Program Representative – At your last meeting, I reviewed this issue with the Board regarding designating the Central Virginia Housing Coalition as the County's representative for the Indoor Plumbing Program. Last year the County had available approximately \$17,000 for this purpose; however, none of the funds were used for this purpose. The Central Virginia Housing Coalition is working with other RADCO member jurisdictions with the goal of representing the RADCO region in administering this worthwhile program.

Recommendation: 1. Rescind the designation of the Rappahannock Area Agency on Aging as the County's representative to administer the Indoor Plumbing Program; and
2. Designate the Central Virginia Housing Coalition as the County's Indoor Plumbing Program representative

Information Items

- 11. Supplemental Appropriation Request – I have received correspondence from Dr. Frank DeForest, Chairman of the King George County CPMT indicating a need for supplemental funds. Dr. DeForest has indicated a shortfall in funding for mandated services totaling \$95,264 for the coming quarter, and the local share would be \$34,588.00. At the time of the preparation of the Board books, there was a discrepancy in the actual amount of funds being requested. Representatives of the County CPMT have been invited to attend the meeting to discuss this matter with the Board. Should clarification of the total amount required become available, I would recommend this item be moved to Action Items for Board action.

- 12. **Census 2000 Update** – Staff has been working with representatives of the Fredericksburg Census 2000 office to establish dates and times for census representatives to be available to assist King George citizens with completion of the census forms. A representative will be available in the Smoot Memorial Library on the following days and times **beginning the week of March 13 through April 15, 2000**:
