



RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF KING GEORGE COUNTY, VIRGINIA: ACCEPTING A FINAL DRAFT OF THE JOINT LAND USE STUDY THAT WAS CONDUCTED TO PROMOTE COMMUNITY GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT THAT IS COMPATIBLE WITH THE FORT A.P. HILL TRAINING AND OPERATIONAL MISSION.

WHEREAS, the Board Supervisors of King George County, Virginia desired to participate with the Towns of Bowling Green, and Port Royal Virginia; Caroline County, Virginia; Essex County, Virginia; and Spotsylvania County Virginia; Fort A.P. Hill and the Office of Economic Adjustment, to develop a Joint Land Use Study Program, to develop zoning recommendations around Fort A.P. Hill; and

WHEREAS, through the process facilitated with an outside consultant has been completed; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of King George County, Virginia, to utilize the recommendations pertaining to King George County, Virginia found within the Joint Land Use Study that would ensure that development would not impede military training at Fort A.P. Hill.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF KING GEORGE COUNTY VIRIGNIA:

1. King George County accepts and approves the final Joint Land Use Study document as it pertains to King George County, Virginia to ensure development around Fort A.P. Hill is compatible to ensure continued usability by the Department of Defense.


