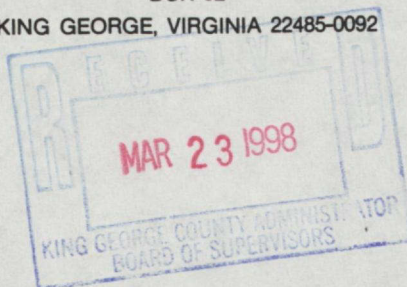

RE: Expiration of Emergency Pump & Haul Permit - Pern's Supermarket, Kings Pizza, Cox's Auto

Dear Mr. Patel,

As stated in correspondence dated February 23, 1998, the existing **Emergency Pump & Haul** permit for the above referenced establishments expires on April 15, 1998. As outlined in 12VAC5-610-550, (Section 3.11 **Permanent pump and haul**) of the Commonwealth of Virginia's Sewage Handling and Disposal Regulations, **Permanent** pump and haul may be permitted with very specific requirements. *All pump and haul operations extending beyond one year shall be considered as a Permanent pump and haul operation, and must meet the requirements of section 3.11.* To date, this office has not received a complete Application for Pump & Haul. Please note that after evaluation by this office, the applicant must have concurrence of the local political subdivision, King George County, in order for a Permanent Pump & Haul permit to be issued.

Therefore, effective April 15, 1998, all operations of the above referenced establishments must be suspended. Suspension of operations shall continue until a Permanent Pump & Haul permit has been issued and a repair/replacement proposal has been submitted as required by this office (per correspondence dated February 23, 1998).
