**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE ACQUISITION BY CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS
THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS TAX MAP 25-61 FOR THE PURPOSE OF A HIGH SCHOOL
SITE**


WHEREAS, by resolution adopted June 5, 2001, the Board of Supervisors of King George County declared the County's intention to proceed with the acquisition of a portion of property known as Tax Map 25-61 for the purpose of a high school site; and

WHEREAS, the County directed that certain studies of the site be completed including but not limited to a boundary survey and an appraisal; and


WHEREAS, said studies, survey and appraisal have been completed; and

WHEREAS, the County desires that a bona fide offer based on said appraisal be made to the property owners in accordance with the requirements of the Code of Virginia; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the King George County Board of Supervisors on this 20th day of February, 2002 that the County Attorney is hereby authorized and directed to present on behalf of the County a bona fide offer for the purchase of 161.31 acres of Tax Map 25-61 in King George County, Virginia for the purpose of a high school site and to report at the first regular meeting in March, 2002 as to the rejection or acceptance of said bona fide offer.
