
Thank you for your letter dated March 17, 1998 regarding the progress at the tire pile site. USA Waste is aware of our obligation to design and provide funding for the construction of a park and recreation center at a site of the County's choosing.

The needs assessment you mentioned will go a long way in ultimately choosing a site. We will be prepared to begin the design process once the site is designated and we are provided with the necessary site related data. We will require at least the following to get started: survey information including utility locations and easements, meets and bounds, a description of soil conditions, and an end use plan for the facility.

The process can be greatly enhanced if our designer is able to work with a Parks and Rec. representative during the design phase of the construction. This will help keep design costs down and leave more money for site development.

Please continue to keep me updated and we will make the necessary arrangements to ensure this project moves forward.
