



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE  
“GOLD STANDARD” INCENTIVE APPLICATION TO THE VIRGINIA OPIOID  
ABATEMENT AUTHORITY TO SECURE OPPORTUNITY FOR INCREASED LOCAL  
OPIOID ABATEMENT FUNDING

WHEREAS, the Opioid Abatement Authority (OAA) has incentivized “gold standard” project eligibility criteria, accounting, and reporting requirements for expenditures by localities of all opioid abatement settlement proceeds by best practices; and

WHEREAS, for each fiscal year that a locality commits to the OAA’s “gold standard” requirements, it will be eligible for a 25% increase in eligible funds for purposes of opioid abatement to be dispersed by the OAA; and

WHEREAS, the incentive application is a commitment to submit to terms and conditions for expenditures promulgated by the OAA; and

WHEREAS, maximizing the funds available to King George County for opioid abatement serves the public health, safety, and welfare, and streamlining expenditures for those efforts regardless of the funding source promotes efficiency and accountability.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of King George County that the County Administrator is authorized to execute the incentive application or term sheet to the OAA in such form as may be approved by the County Attorney to commit to “gold standard” practices for opioid abatement expenditures in fiscal years 2023 and 2024.
