



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE A LETTER REQUESTING
THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY RELINQUISH JURISDICTION OF NAVAL
SUPPORT ACTIVITY SOUTH POTOMAC AND GRANT CONCURRENT JURISDICTION
FOR CRIMINAL MISCONDUCT BY JUVENILES

WHEREAS, the Navy has limited remedies for juvenile offenders that are not subject to the Uniform Code of Military Justice; and

WHEREAS, federal law provides for retrocession of exclusive federal jurisdiction in certain circumstances pursuant to 10 USC § 2683; and

WHEREAS, the King George County Sheriff and King George County Commonwealth's Attorney support initiating a process that would result in County law enforcement accepting concurrent jurisdiction of criminal misconduct by juveniles.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED to authorize that the Chairman sign a letter of support approved as to form by the County Attorney requesting that the Department of the Navy relinquish jurisdiction of Naval Support Activity South Potomac and grant concurrent jurisdiction for criminal misconduct by juveniles.
