**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE
ADOPTING THE GEORGE WASHINGTON REGIONAL COMMISSION
DAHLGREN BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY PLAN**

WHEREAS, the George Washington Regional Commission (“the Commission”) is the Planning District Commission serving the City of Fredericksburg, Caroline, King George, Spotsylvania, and Stafford counties, known together as Planning District 16; and

WHEREAS, the DAHLGREN BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY PLAN was presented to the King George County Board of Supervisors at its January 21, 2025, regular meeting; and

WHEREAS, the proposed plan serves to update the 2018 Trailways Master Plan and aligns with the King George County Comprehensive Plan. It aims to enhance the safety of King George County residents in light of the increasing traffic along Route 301 and supports the development of Dahlgren as a small town; and

WHEREAS, the emphasis of the Dahlgren Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Plan is on ensuring the safety of residents in King George County, particularly in light of potential future commercial and residential development; and


WHEREAS, VDOT has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation herein for compliance with safety and design guidelines for high-level preliminary planning; and

WHEREAS, this plan was published on the GWRC website, properly advertised for a public hearing, and received public comment, which was presented to the Board of Supervisors at its regular meeting held on March 04, 2025; and
