**A RESOLUTION DIRECTING STAFF TO REVIEW THE HEIGHT
REQUIREMENTS FOR DATA CENTER DEVELOPMENT WITHIN KING GEORGE
COUNTY**

WHEREAS, the King George County Board of Supervisors recognizes the increasing demand for data center development within the region; and

WHEREAS, data centers are critical to the technological infrastructure and economic development of the community; and

WHEREAS, the development of data centers may have specific needs regarding building height limitations for operational purposes; and

WHEREAS, ensuring that data center developments comply with community zoning, environmental, and infrastructure standards is essential to maintaining the balance between economic growth and community well-being;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of King George County, Virginia does hereby initiate text amendments of the King George County Code to review the height requirements for data center development and directs staff to prepare such amendments for consideration by the Planning Commission and the Board of Supervisors. The Planning Commission shall hold at least one public hearing on the
