**A RESOLUTION DIRECTING STAFF TO REVIEW THE HEIGHT  
REQUIREMENTS FOR INDUSTRIAL USES WITHIN KING GEORGE COUNTY**


**WHEREAS**, the King George County Board of Supervisors recognizes the increasing demand for industrial development within the region; and

**WHEREAS**, industrial development, including data centers, are critical to the technological infrastructure and economic development of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, industrial users may have specific needs requiring greater building height allowances for operational purposes and the King George County Board of Supervisors recognizes the need to consider these requests on a case by case basis;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of King George County, Virginia does hereby initiate text amendments of the King George County Code, Industrial District Regulations, and directs staff to prepare such amendments for consideration by the Planning Commission and the Board of Supervisors. The Planning Commission shall hold at least one public hearing on the consideration of amendment(s) of said Ordinance and shall forward its recommendation to the Board of Supervisors in accordance with the law.
