**A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE RURAL TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY
COMMITTEE (RTAC) TO ADVISE THE GEORGE WASHINGTON REGIONAL
COMMISSION (GWRC) BOARD ON RURAL TRANSPORTATION**

WHEREAS, King George County recognizes the importance of a robust and efficient transportation network for its residents, particularly in rural areas where access to transportation options can be limited and where maintaining infrastructure is a priority; and

WHEREAS, the Rural Transportation Advisory Committee (RTAC) plays a crucial role in advising the George Washington Regional Commission (GWRC) Board on transportation-related issues and the needs of rural communities within the region, ensuring that transportation planning and decision-making reflect the interests and concerns of these communities; and

WHEREAS, King George County supports efforts to strengthen regional collaboration and improve transportation planning by ensuring that rural communities have a consistent and active voice in discussions regarding transportation needs, challenges, and solutions; and

WHEREAS, holding quarterly meetings of the Rural Transportation Advisory Committee (RTAC) will provide the necessary frequency and consistency to address emerging issues, assess the status of ongoing transportation projects, and ensure the continued alignment of regional transportation planning with the needs of rural areas; and


WHEREAS, regular quarterly meetings will facilitate the timely review and discussion of key topics, including public transit accessibility, transportation infrastructure improvements, funding priorities, and long-term mobility solutions that will benefit rural residents of King George County and surrounding areas; and

WHEREAS, King George County believes that quarterly meetings of RTAC will improve communication and foster better coordination between local governments, the GWRC Board, and the citizens of the region, ensuring that transportation issues are addressed with the attention they deserve;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of King George County, Virginia, that the Board expresses its strong support for the Rural Transportation Advisory Committee (RTAC) to meet on a quarterly basis and to continue advising the George Washington Regional Commission (GWRC) Board on rural transportation matters.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the King George County Board of Supervisors encourages the GWRC Board to approve and implement this schedule for quarterly meetings of RTAC, recognizing the vital role it plays in promoting a comprehensive and equitable transportation system for all residents, including those in rural communities.
