**RESOLUTION OF THE KING GEORGE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
RECOMMENDING THE APPOINTMENT OF CHARLES FREDERICK
HERTENSTEIN IV TO THE KING GEORGE COUNTY BOARD OF ZONING
APPEALS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 15.2-2308 of the Code of Virginia, appointments to the Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA) are made by the Circuit Court upon the recommendation of the local governing body; and

WHEREAS, there is a term vacancy on the King George County Board of Zoning Appeals; and

WHEREAS, the King George County Board of Supervisors desires to recommend a qualified individual to serve on the BZA in order to ensure the continued lawful and effective administration of the County's zoning ordinances and appeals processes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has reviewed and considered potential candidates and finds that Charles F. Hertenstein IV, a resident of King George County, is qualified and willing to serve;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the King George County Board of Supervisors on this 6th day of May, 2025, that it hereby recommends to the Judge of the Circuit Court of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Virginia the appointment of to the King George County Board of

Zoning Appeals, for a term of five (5) years, commencing June 01, 2025 and expiring June 30th 2030, or until a successor is duly appointed and qualified;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Administrator is hereby directed to transmit this resolution, along with all required supporting documentation, to the Circuit Court for consideration and action.
