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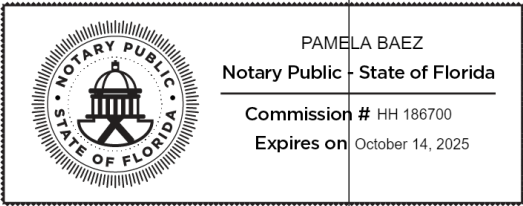

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR Application Z-2024-00184, Open Road Renewables and Gibson Solar I, LLC

The Board of Supervisors of King George County will hold a Public Hearing for Application Z-2024-00184, Open Road Renewables and Gibson Solar I, LLC, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, July 15, 2025, at the Horace A. Revercomb Administration Building Board Room, 10459 Courthouse Drive, King George, Virginia, 22485, and via electronic participation, as set forth below.

Representatives from Open Road Renewables and Gibson Solar I, LLC (applicants) have applied for a Special Exception permit to construct a Utility Scale Solar Facility (combined with a Livestock Operation) on approximately 890 acres of private land (made up of 48 tax parcels) located in the Shiloh Magisterial District. The subject parcels are generally located adjacent to Kings Highway at the intersection of Big Timber Road and continue East for approximately 3 miles. Applicants have also requested a determination that the solar facility is "substantially in accord" with the County's Comprehensive Plan in accordance with Virginia Code §15.2-2232. The Planning Commission considered this application at their meeting on June 10, 2025, and voted 5:3 to forward a favorable recommendation to the Board of Supervisors.
