KING GEORGE COUNTY PROCLAMATION DISABILITY VOTING RIGHTS WEEK

WHEREAS, there are over 70 million people of all ages with disabilities living in communities throughout the United States, and

WHEREAS, more than 40 million Americans with disabilities are eligible to vote; and

WHEREAS, there are 2,794 (10.4%) people with disabilities living in King George County; and

WHEREAS, the disability community has a strong interest in policies and decisions at the local, state, and national levels that directly affect their lives; and

WHEREAS, ensuring voting access for people with disabilities is essential to shaping public policies that truly reflect and address their needs; and

WHEREAS, the Disability Resource Center of the Rappahannock Area is joining REV UP Virginia, which stands for "Register! Educate! Vote! Use Your Power," is a statewide effort to build the voting power of disabled Virginians; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that King George County, Virginia hereby proclaims the week of September 8 - 12, 2025, shall be recognized as National Disability Voter Registration Week in King George County, Virginia.
