

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING OF KING GEORGE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

The King George County Board of Supervisors will hold public hearings on Tuesday, December 2, 2025, at 5:30 pm, or as soon thereafter as may be heard, in the Robert H. Combs Board Room of the Revercomb Administration Building, 10459 Courthouse Drive, King George, Virginia, to receive public comment and consider the following:

King George County, Virginia - Code of Ordinances Chapter 14 - TAXATION

1. An amendment to the Personal Property Ordinance.

The proposed amendment aims to provide clarification regarding the filing of annual personal property forms.

The proposed amendment will:

State the alternate methods of collecting information regarding ownership of personal property located in King George County.

2. An amendment to the Transient Occupancy Tax Ordinance.

The proposed amendment will add a section that mandates an attestation document to be submitted annually to the Commissioner of the Revenue Office by an accommodation provider.

The full text of the proposed ordinance revisions are available for public inspection in the Commissioner of the Revenue, Revercomb Administration Building, 10459 Courthouse Drive, King George, Virginia, 22485 during regular business hours, and on the County's website at www.kinggeorgecountyva.gov.
