### **Holiday Shopping Tips**

- Even though you may be rushed and have many things on your mind, be aware of your surroundings. If possible, shop before dark and coordinate trips with a friend.
- Never Park in an unlit lot or area, no matter how convenient it is.
- Remove all valuables from your vehicle. Keep your vehicle doors locked and windows closed; this is especially important for SUVs.
- Have your keys readily available in your hand before you go to your car.
- When you return to your vehicle, scan the inside of your car to be sure no one is hiding inside. Check to see if you are being followed.
- Avoid carrying large amounts of cash. Pay for purchases with a check, credit card, or debit card whenever possible.

### ***Winter Weather***

Brrrr! We hope most travelers can spend this cold weather indoors, safe and warm. But if you must venture out, plan to use extreme caution driving on roads in the area. Any wet pavement remaining after snow will freeze overnight. Gusting winds during the day helped to dry pavements after the snow stopped, assisted by treatment materials applied by VDOT crews, but any lingering puddles or damp areas will freeze. Travelers should stay alert for patches of transparent ice on road surfaces. If it looks wet, assume it's ice. Reduce speed. Add extra travel time to avoid rushing. Slow down before crossing a bridge or overpass or entering a ramp.
