Any wet pavement remaining after snow will freeze overnight. Gusting winds during the day helped to dry pavements after the snow stopped, assisted by treatment materials applied by VDOT crews, but any lingering puddles or damp areas will freeze. Travelers should stay alert for patches of transparent ice on road surfaces. If it looks wet, assume it's ice. Reduce speed. Add extra travel time to avoid rushing. Slow down before crossing a bridge or overpass or entering a ramp.
