### **Winter reminders**

To take care of your outside pets during this bitter cold and winter weather! Keep your pets warm and dry by either letting them inside or providing them with proper shelter, extra bedding, food, and water. It's the law! During cold weather, VA law requires you to either bring your pets inside or provide adequate shelter that keeps your pets protected, has a windbreak at its entrance and provides a quantity of bedding that is sufficient to protect the animal from cold and promote the retention of body heat. See Virginia Code 3.2-6500 for more information.

As we prepare for the potential impact of a severe winter storm, residents are reminded to use generators and alternative heating sources safely. These devices should only be operated in well-ventilated areas to reduce the risk of carbon monoxide poisoning. Generators should never be used indoors, in garages, or near open windows or doors. To prevent electrical hazards, please ensure that all extension cords are in good condition and free from fraying or other damage.

While the winter weather continues our E-911 communications officers are staying put—sleeping overnight at the sheriff's office to ensure calls for help are answered without delay. This level of dedication doesn't always make headlines, but it makes a difference. Thank you for being there when KG needs you most.
